



Final Call for Papers

Prof Jerzy Kojkoł and Ewa Stachowska, PhD would like to invite Polish scholars and researchers in religious studies to submit articles to “Przegląd Religioznawczy – The Religious Studies Review” (no 4/2016). All submissions must engage topics related to

Religion and religiosity in Polish context

Topics might include, but are not limited to, the following:

transformations of religiosity, religious pluralism, new spirituality, relation between religion and politics, religion and public discourse, deinstitutionalization of religion, religion and tradition, relation between sacrum and profanum, religious institution and third sector

The deadline for the submission of proposals for topics and abstracts (up to 250 words): 7 December 2016.

The deadline for the submission of papers (after the acceptance of your abstract), along with abstracts and keywords in English: 27 December 2016.

All papers should be original and written in English or Polish. The maximum length of articles is 40 000 characters, including spaces and footnotes (the Polish Referencing Style). Below are some examples of referencing:

A chapter in an edited book – A. Wójtowicz, *Naturalizm religijny*, in: *Oblicza religii i religijności*, I. Borowik, M. Libiszowska-Żółtkowska, J. Doktor (eds.), ZW Nomos, Kraków 2008, pp. 39-40.

Articles will be subject to an editorial and technical review. After this initial stage, all articles will be reviewed by two independent reviewers.
